Article 1 COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT

80.1.1 Establishment

A Committee of Adjustment is hereby constituted for the City.

80.1.2 Composition

The Committee of Adjustment shall be composed of five persons, none of whom shall be members of Council or employees of the City and who shall be appointed by by-law of Council to hold office for a term co-extensive with the term of Council.

80.1.3 Term of office

Members of the Committee shall hold office until their successors are appointed, and are eligible for reappointment, and, where a member ceases to be a member before the expiration of the designated term, Council shall appoint another eligible person for the unexpired portion of the term.

80.1.4 Vacancy

A vacancy in the membership of the Committee or the absence or inability of a member to act does not impair the powers of the Committee, provided there is a quorum.

80.1.5 Remuneration

Members of the Committee shall be paid such remuneration as Council shall determine by resolution from time to time.

**Article 2
PRACTICE****80.2.1 Chairman - elected**

The members of the Committee shall elect one of themselves as chairman, and, when the chairman is absent through illness or otherwise, the Committee may appoint another member to act as acting chairman.

80.2.2 Quorum

Three members of the Committee shall constitute a quorum. By-law 87-168, 17 August, 1987.
