Chapter 880 SOLICITATION OF CONTRIBUTIONS OF MONEY ON HIGHWAYS

Article 1 SOLICITING - PROHIBITED

Article 1 SOLICITING - PROHIBITED

880.1.1 Days fixed by Council - exception

No person or organization engaged in charitable or patriotic work may solicit contributions of money from persons on the highways of the City except on days fixed for the purpose by Council. By-law 87-176, 17 August, 1987; By-law 88-125, 18 July, 1988.

880.1.2 Application - person - organization

Any person or organization engaged in charitable or patriotic work wishing to so solicit contributions of money may make application to Council to fix days for that purpose by filing the same with the Clerk. By-law 87-176, 17 August, 1987.

Article 2
ENFORCEMENT

880.2.1 Fine - for contravention

Every person who contravenes any provision of this Chapter is guilty of an offence and is liable, upon conviction, to a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000), exclusive of costs, for each offence, recoverable under the *Provincial Offences Act*.
