Article 1

INTERPRETATION

741.1.1 Council - defined

“Council” means the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Richmond Hill. By-law 243-91, 8 July, 1991.

741.1.2 Committee of the Whole - defined

“Committee of the Whole” means the Committee of the Whole of the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Richmond Hill pursuant to Chapter 38 of the Town of Richmond Hill Municipal Code (Procedure).

Article 2**HEARING - ON SIGN - ADVERTISING DEVICE****741.2.1 Committee - authority - opportunity - to be heard**

The Committee of the Whole shall conduct and is hereby authorized to conduct all hearings required to be held to determine whether a by-law shall be passed to prohibit or regulate signs and other advertising devices or any class or classes thereof, and the position of notices on buildings or vacant lots within any defined area or areas or on land abutting on any defined highway or part of a highway, and the Committee of the Whole shall afford such person an opportunity to be heard in the place and stead of Council.

741.2.2 Report - written - to Council - after hearing

Where a hearing is conducted by the Committee of the Whole as aforesaid, such Committee shall, as soon as practical, make a written report to Council, as required by the provisions of the *Municipal Act*.

741.2.3 Report - received - Council authority - to act

Council, upon receiving and considering the report of the Committee of the Whole referred to in Section 741.2.2, shall be entitled to do any act, pass any by-law or make any decision that it might have done, passed or made had it conducted the hearing itself, without affording the person or persons affected by such action a further opportunity to be heard.
